This enabled Brunswick Organic Nursery to purchase spray heads and lines to equip eight polythene tunnels in order to improve the efficiency of their irrigation system.

Brunswick is a workplace where adults with learning difficulties, "**Workers**", are supported to produce goods which are sold in their shop.

They met the manager of the nursery, Adam Myers, his staff and, more importantly, the "**workers**".

It soon became evident when talking to them how proud, enthusiastic and happy they were to be able to work together at the nursery, playing a very important role in the organisation.
