

CAMALODUNUM LODGE NO 660 CELEBRATES 150 YEARS

Tuesday the 14th March 2006 was a significant date in the history of the Lodge in Malton when it met to celebrate the 150th anniversary of its consecration. The brethren, 108 in number, gathered in the Lodge rooms used continually since 1856 and a mere 200 yards away from the hotel where the Lodge was first consecrated. There was an impressive array of distinguished guests from not only the Province of Yorkshire North & East Ridings, but also the West Riding of Yorkshire and from Durham.

The meeting, presided over in part by the Provincial Grand Master Richard John Anderson, witnessed the dedication of a new Volume of Sacred Law and the presentation of a brief history of the last fifty years as researched by Bro Fred Francis. The Provincial Grand Master also presented to the Lodge new Wardens Columns, received as a gift from the Master, John Parks.

The evening was crowned with the presentation of a cheque for £4,000 to the Provincial Grand Master towards the RMTGB 2006 Festival.
